Lazy Girl Pecan Pie Bars

Crust: 2 cups all purpose flour
1/2 cup granulated sugar
2 sticks butter
1/2 tsp. Salt

Pecan Pie Bar Filling: 4 large eggs
1/2 cups light corn syrup
3/4 cup granulated sugar
3/4 cup brown sugar, firmly packed
3 tbsp. Butter, melted
1 1/2 tsp. Vanilla extract
2 1/2 cups pecans, in pieces

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. In a large bowl or standing mixer combine flour, 1/2 cup sugar 1/2 tsp. Salt, and 2 sticks butter. Mix well. Mixture will be dry and crumbly.

In a large pan (10x15) grease bottom of pan, (Parchment paper to line) pour the crust mixture onto greased pan and press firmly to create crust. Bake in oven for 10 minutes at 350 degrees.

In separate bowl, combine eggs, corn syrup, sugar, brown sugar, melted butter, vanilla extract, and chopped pecans; Mix well. Set aside til crust is done baking.

After 10 minutes, remove crust from oven. Pour prepared pecan filling mixture on top of hot crust. Use a spatula or spoon to distribute evenly.

Place back in oven. Bake for 35 minutes at 350 degrees.

Let cool and serve.
