BE IT KNOWN THAT the Crittenden County Conservation District, 118 East Bellville Street, Marion, Kentucky 42064 is accepting BIDS FOR A GENERAL CONTRACTOR to assess work needed and to determine costs of each job individually. Bids will be accepted until April 3, 2026.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:
Move furniture away from walls and return furniture after completed drywall repair/paint, and after carpet install. Trim out.

1. Repair small areas of drywall and prepare for painting.
2. Remove baseboard
3. Paint all common area with #2 coats of premium paint.
4. Replace all baseboard with PVC 1x4. Approximately 300 ft.
5. Remove and dispose of carpet.
6. Install Pergo DuraCraft or equivalent LVT flooring in foyer, main office, tech room and hallway to restrooms. Approximately 1500 square feet.
7. Provide matching thresholds.

This project is to be BID by cost for each area of work such as Phase I: Current floor & baseboard removal and disposal, furniture movement, wall preparation, and painting. Then, Phase II: Furniture movement, install new flooring & baseboard, thresholds replacement, furniture movement back in place. Conservation District will pay for all consumer materials.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS: Contractor holds all licenses required to conduct business in the City of Marion and County of Crittenden.

- Contractor shall provide all necessary permits.
- Contractor shall meet project timelines as accepted in the bid.
- Contractor shall provide labor and equipment necessary to complete the work outlined.

Notice is hereby given that the Fiscal Court of Crittenden County Kentucky, at its regular meeting held on March 19, 2026, at 6:00 o'clock p.m., gave reading and passed and adopted an Ordinance relating to the Ordinances of the Crittenden County Fiscal Court. A summary of the Ordinance is as follows:

A majority of the Fiscal Court having found an emergency to exist due to the financial condition of the Jail Fund, adopted this Ordinance which decreases budgeted receipts in the amount of \$24,000.00 and also decreases the budgeted appropriations in the same amount.
