was receiving reports of a restaurant coming to the old Wiser Oil property at Leeco.

J.O. Bowen of Powell County addressed the court about the Daniel Boone Country Byways and New Virginia Road. He reported that there would be a Memorial Ride and the members of the Byways was wanting to put a low water bridge on the New Virginia Road with portable concrete rail-road ties.

Judge Mays and Road Foreman McIntosh stated that they did not see a problem so a motion was made by Rodney Ross and seconded by Tim Brandenburg to give the group permission.

A representative of the flood buy out plan for Beattyville informed the Court that offers would be made to the land owners next week and it would be 7-10 days and they would receive their money.

Tina Johnson representing LiKen reported

that there were approximately 120 tires still left in the Kentucky River and there would be another cleanup in August.

Judge Mays then noted for the record that the Magistrates and himself had received bank balances/ financial reports as of February 28, 2026 and a copy of claims adjustments from the February 2026 meeting and a list of claims for March 2026. Also that the Lee County Clerk had submitted excess fee payment of \$782.48 with amended 2025 annual report. Judge Mays reported that due to conflicting dates the April Fiscal Court meeting would be held Tuesday, April 14th, 2026.

In Agenda matters - Tim Brandenburg made a motion with Dean Noe seconding to approve the minutes of the February 2026 meeting.

A motion was made by Dean Noe and seconded by Dennis Pelfrey to approve a Park Maintenance

Agreement between Lock 14 Hydro Partners, LLC and Lee County Fiscal Court in the amount of \$8,000.

A KYTC Resolution to approve county roads as listed Appendix A that are a part of the county road system and Appendix B that are not a part of the county road system was made by Dennis Pelfrey and seconded by Tim Brandenburg.

Rodney Ross made a motion with Tim Brandenburg seconding to approve opening a Seizure and Forfeiture Account at Citizens Bank for Lee County Jailer Justin Shuler.

A motion was made to approve Lee County Sheriff Joe Lucas reported for pay increase for Debbie Noble to \$11.77 hourly wage effective February 26th to be consecutive with payroll. Dean Noe made the motion with Tim Brandenburg seconding.

Rodney Ross made a motion with Tim Brandenburg seconding to approve Gregory Smallwood, Jr. (Buddy) full time hire, Deputy Sheriff at \$18.00 hourly wage effective March 1, 2026, with 3 months probation.

A motion was made by Dean Noe and seconded by Tim Brandenburg to

approve Joshua Bailey full time hire, Advance EMT at \$13.50 hourly wage effective March 2, 2026 with 3 months probation.

Dennis Pelfrey made the motion with Tim Brandenburg seconding to remove the Bill Charles Cemetery Road from the Lee County Road system.

Claims and transfer were discussed and approved as presented by a motion made by Dean Noe and seconded by Tim Brandenburg.

Dean Noe made a motion to adjourn with the April meeting scheduled for Tuesday, April 14, 2026.
