Carlisle man arrested on drug charges

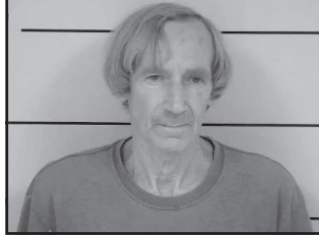

desk inside the bedroom, to the left of the door, a green leafy substance, consistent with marijuana, white powder residue, consistent with methamphetamine, and a spoon with white powder residue on it, also consistent with methamphetamine. Upon asking, Mr. Browning gave consent and was present during a search for more possible drug-related items.

While looking in the desk drawers, Deputy Sparks and Officer Copher, Jr. located several glass pipes with visible residue (one was field tested positive for methamphetamine), a small

glass vial containing one large solid crystalline substance (field tested positive for methamphetamine), a medium size glass vial with apparent burnt residue, consistent with methamphetamine reurn (tested positive for methamphetamine).

Officer Copher, Jr. located in a different drawer on the desk, a zip lock back containing a green leafy substance, which Mr. Browning stated was marijuana, and a small nail container with a compartment containing a green leafy substance, consistent with marijuana.

Larry W. Browning was subsequently arrested and transported to the Bourbon County Detention Center on a \$5,000.00 cash bond and is scheduled for arraignment in Nicholas County District Court on Wednesday, Feb. 18, 2026, at 9:00am.

All persons are to be considered innocent until proven guilty or pleading guilty in a court of law.

Mr. Browning invited Deputy Sparks and Officer Copher, Jr. into his bedroom to show them the rifles, when Deputy Sparks observed on the
